**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Pampa Investment Group, LP to obtain a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Bell County.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs Pampa to provide notice of the application as described in the January 27, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, using the included forms attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Pampa to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation in Bell County	March 12, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	March 23, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
