ORDER NO. 8
REQUESTING CLARIFICATION

This Order addresses the application of Integra Water Texas, LLC for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Bastrop County. Integra’s response to question number seven of the application states, “The development is located outside of any municipal or district boundaries and is not subject to any franchise, permit or consent granted by a city or district.”¹ However, the proposed sewer utility tariff filed as an attachment to Commission Staff’s final recommendation contains language stating, “The rates set or approved by the city for the systems entirely within its corporate boundary are not presented in [this] tariff. Those rates are not under the original jurisdiction of the PUC and will have to be obtained from the city or utility.”²

By October 1, 2021, Commission Staff must confirm that the requested area is not within any city’s corporate boundary or extraterritorial jurisdiction. If Commission Staff confirms the requested area is not within a city’s corporate boundary or extraterritorial jurisdiction, Commission Staff must file comments on whether it is appropriate to include language regarding such in the proposed tariff.
