COME NOW, Integra Water Texas, LLC (Integra or Applicant) files this Response to Order No. 9¹.

On September 24, 2021, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 9, requesting additional information regarding the date service will begin for all phases of construction, as required by 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25(b)(1)(B). The Order requires this information be provided by October 1, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

In response to the ALJ's request, both Phase 1 and Phase 2 have been constructed by the developer. Phase 1 was sold in August 2021, and Integra is currently taking applications. Phase 2 was sold in the first week of September, 2021, by the developer, and applications are expected to commence by October 2021. Integra expects all 374 connections to be tied into the system by December 2021 and service to begin as soon as requested by customers.
