On October 8, 2021, the Notice of Approval was filed in this docket, which requires Integra to file proof of recording.¹

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), parties may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Integra Water Texas, LLC (Integra) has been diligently working with Bastrop County to ensure the recording requirements are met. However, the process has been delayed due to a transition in Bastrop County's filing system and changes in the County's preferred documentation for recording.
