## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the January 8, 2021, petition of Trendmaker Homes, Inc. to amend MSEC's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County by streamlined expedited release, and the sufficiency of the petition and notice.

On February 4, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the petition and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete and notice sufficient.

Under the provisions of Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, if streamlined expedited release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.254(h), this proceeding is not a contested case and no opportunity for hearing is provided. However, under 16 TAC § 24.245(h)(6), MSEC may submit a response to the Commission. Accordingly, by February 19, 2021, MSEC may submit a response, verified by a notarized affidavit, to the petition.
