METHOD USED TO ALLOCATE UTILITY CHARGES (CHECK ALL THAT APPLY):

Occupancy method: The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by the total number of occupants in all dwelling units at the beginning of the utility's billing period.

■ Ratio occupancy method: The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit is adjusted as shown in the table at right. This adjusted value is divided by the total of these values for all dwelling units at the beginning of the retail public utility's billing period. (The idea behind this method is that increased occupancy does not result in an equal increase in usage.)

Estimated occupancy method: The estimated occupancy in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by the total estimated occupancy of all dwelling units. The estimated occupancy for each unit is based on the number of bedrooms and is determined from the table at right.

Occupancy and dwelling unit size: At least 50 percent of the utility bill for water/wastewater consumption is allocated using the occupancy method checked above. The remainder is allocated according to either:

- ! the size of the tenant's dwelling unit divided by the total size of all dwelling units or
- ! the size of the space rented for the tenant's manufactured home divided by the total of size of all manufactured home spaces
- Submetered hot water: The individually submetered hot water used in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by all submetered hot water used in all dwelling units.
- Submetered cold water is used to affocate charges for hot water provided through a central system: The individually submetered cold water used in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by all submetered cold water used in all dwelling units.
