**ORDER NO. 2
GRANTING INTERVENTION,
FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE, AND PROVIDING
AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order grants intervention and addresses the administrative completeness of the petition of Sanctuary Texas, LLC to amend Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Denton County by streamlined expedited release, filed on January 20, 2021. On February 18, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness and notice of the petition.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively incomplete. The petitioner must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Pai Liu's February 18, 2021 memorandum attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.


The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:
