Quadvest,L.P has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) no. 11612 and No. 20952 for the provision of retail water and sewer utility service in Fort Bend County.

The requested area overlaps the district boundaries of the Fort Bend County <u>Drainage District</u> and <u>North Fort Bend Water Authority</u>. If Fort Bend County <u>Drainage District</u> and <u>North Fort Bend Water Authority</u> do not request a public hearing, the <u>Commission shall</u> determine that the district or entity is consenting to the Quadvest, L.P.'s request to provide retail water and sewe utility service in the requested area.


