

## ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Quadvest, L.P. The petitioner seeks approval for the addition of 67 acres to its certificates of convenience and necessity service area in Fort Bend County.

On May 24, 2021, Quadvest filed the affidavit of Yvette McNellie, Partner of Quadvest, attesting that notice to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties was provided on April 26, 2021. A representative copy of the notices and accompanying map were attached to the affidavit. Additionally, Quadvest filed a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice of the application in *Houston Chronicle dba Katy Rancher*, a newspaper of general circulation in Fort Bend County, on May 5 and 12, 2021.

On June 15, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice. Commission Staff recommends that that the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient. The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for further processing of the application:

Deadline to intervene	June 11, 2021 <sup>1</sup>
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	July 22, 2021
Deadline for Quadvest to file signed consent forms with the Commission	August 5, 2021

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Under 16 TAC § 24.235(a)(3), the intervention period is 30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer. Notice was mailed on April 26, 2021, and published on May 5 and 12, 2021. Therefore, 30 days after May 12, 2021 is June 11, 2021.

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	August 12, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	August 19, 2021
