COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 22, 2021, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Fort Bend County, Texas under Texas Water Code §§ 13.242 through 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 through 24.237. On February 1, 2021, Quadvest filed supplemental mapping information, and on February 4, 2021, Quadvest filed supplemental financial information. Quadvest seeks to amend an area of 67 acres with no current customers to its existing CCNs.

On June 18, 2021, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 4, which established a deadline of July 22, 2021, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent.

I. REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff has informally requested the registration and permit numbers for the public water system and wastewater system that will provide service to the requested area. Quadvest has not yet provided the information. Contemporaneous with this filing, Staff is submitting its second request for information to Quadvest to obtain the necessary information. Because Staff cannot provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to Quadvest without this information, Staff requests that the procedural schedule be amended as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	August 20 2021
Deadline for Quadvest to file signed consent forms with the Commission	September 3, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 10, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	September 17, 2021

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons specified above, Staff respectfully requests that the procedural schedule be amended.
