COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On January 22, 2021, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Fort Bend County, Texas under Texas Water Code §§ 13.242 through 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 through 24.237. Quadvest seeks to amend an area of 67 acres with no current customers to its existing CCNs.

On October 8, 2021, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 7, which established a deadline of November 11, 2021, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. On November 2, 2021, Quadvest provided documentation demonstrating Texas Commission on Environmental Quality approval of the construction plans for the facilities and infrastructure necessary to provide water and sewer service to the requested area. However, Quadvest has not yet provided an executed developer agreement. As indicated in Quadvest's October 29, 2021 pending request for extension, Quadvest anticipates that the developer agreement will be signed no later than November 30, 2021. Staff therefore requests that the deadline to file a final recommendation on the application be extended to December 30, 2021 and the deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law be extended to January 6, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline for its final recommendation be extended to December 30, 2021 and the deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law be extended to January 6, 2022.
