**FINDING COMPLIANCE REPORT SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING**  
**MONTHLY REPORTS**

On February 2, 2024, Commission Staff filed its supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of Mark Patterson's November 15, 2023 filing and whether this docket may be closed.

The administrative law judge finds Mr. Patterson's November 15, 2023 compliance filing sufficient. Mr. Patterson must continue filing all reports required by the Commission's Order in Docket No. 49758.<sup>1</sup> Additionally, if Mr. Patterson is dismissed as the receiver of Oak Shores Waters, Mr. Patterson must file notice with the Commission within 30 days from the date of the order dismissing him as receiver.
