ORDER NO. 21 REQUIRING RECOMMENDATION AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In the Commission's order filed on February 12, 2021, in Docket No. 49758¹ (the Commission's Order), temporary rate provisions were approved for Oak Shores Water System. Ordering paragraph six of the Commission's Order states, "The reconciliation of the temporary rates will begin following the filing of the final report, upon the request of Commission Staff, or as directed by the Commission."

On April 29, 2024, by order of the 459th District Court in Travis County, Texas, in cause number D-1-GN-18-002771, the receivership of Oak Shores Water System was discharged and terminated, and Mark Patterson was discharged from all duties as receiver for Oak Shores Water System.

By May 22, 2024, Commission Staff must file a recommendation regarding reconciliation of the temporary rates and a proposed procedural schedule for processing. Commission Staff's recommendation must also address: (1) the effective date of the expiration of the temporary rates; and (2) the rates that will be effective following the expiration of the temporary rates.
