**GRANTING EXTENSION AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


This Order addresses Mark Patterson's request for an extension filed on March 21, 2025. Mr. Patterson requests additional time to file the documentation necessary for the reconciliation review of the temporary rates approved by the Commission in Docket No. 49758.<sup>1</sup>

The administrative law judge grants the request for an extension and amends the procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for Mr. Patterson to file documentation for the reconciliation review to compare revenues received through the temporary rates to the actual expenses incurred by the utility, including invoices, cancelled checks, or other documentation to support all actual expenses	March 28, 2025
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide a recommendation regarding reconciliation and to file a proposed procedural schedule for the continued processing of this docket	April 11, 2025
