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APPLICATION OF TIMOTHY M. SMITH FOR A RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDIT MICROGENERATOR REGISTRATION PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice of Approval addresses the January 26, 2021 application of Timothy M. Smith to certify his TMS solar system facility as a renewable energy credit (REC) microgenerator, under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.173(o). Mr. Smith filed supplemental information to clarify and correct his application on February 11, 2021. The facility's total rated nameplate capacity is 0.01505 megawatts (MW) and the metered generation eligible for RECs is 0.01505 MW.

On March 5, 2021, Commission Staff recommended approval of Mr. Smith's application, as supplemented. Commission Staff also recommended that this project be restyled as *Application of Timothy M. Smith for a Renewable Energy Credit Microgenerator Registration* because, although the facility for which Mr. Smith is seeking a REC registration is a microgenerator, this is not an application for registration as a microgenerator aggregator.

Under 16 TAC § 25.173(o)(1), Mr. Smith's facility meets the eligibility criteria as outlined in 16 TAC § 25.173(e) because his solar facility qualifies as a new facility. In his application, Mr. Smith included the location, owner, technology, and rated capacity of the facility as required under 16 TAC § 25.173(o)(1).

Accordingly, the Commission certifies Mr. Smith's facility as a REC microgenerator. Any subsequent changes to the information provided in this application must be filed with the Commission as supplements to the application within 30 days of such changes. Additionally, this docket is restyled as reflected in this Notice of Approval.
