**FINDING PETITION INCOMPLETE, NOTICE SUFFICIENT,
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the February 5, 2021 petition of WUSF 5 Rock Creek East, LP and Walton Texas, LP to amend Johnson County Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Tarrant County by streamlined expedited release. On March 5, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness and notice.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review. The ALJ finds the notice sufficient.

On or before April 5, 2021, the applicant must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Alicia Maloy's March 5, 2021 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed.

On or before May 5, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
