FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by the City of Schertz regarding the application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Comal County. On June 18 and 28, 2021, Schertz filed the affidavits of Stephen Mayfield, Schertz's authorized representative, attesting that direct notice was provided to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on June 8 and June 28, 2021.

On August 11, 2021, Schertz filed publisher's affidavits attesting that notice was published in the *San Antonio Express-News*, a newspaper of general circulation in Comal County, on June 9 and 16, 2021.

On September 10, 2021, Commission Staff filed recommendations regarding Schertz's proof of notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Burleson for review and consent	October 15, 2021
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 29, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	November 5, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	November 19, 2021
