**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the February 11, 2021 petition of the City of Georgetown and Jarrell-Schwertner Water Supply Corporation for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity in Williamson County.

On May 24, 2021, Commission Staff filed a supplemental sufficiency recommendation addressing the administrative completeness and sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds that the petitioners have satisfied the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.253(c) and that notice is sufficient.

The ALJ continues to find the application administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By June 21, 2021, applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation filed on May 24, 2021, and the memorandum of Pai Liu, Advisor, Infrastructure Division, dated May 24, 2021.

By July 23, 2021,¹ Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
