ORDER NO. 6
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the February 11, 2021 petition of the City of Georgetown and Jarrell-Schwertner Water Supply Corporation for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity in Williamson County.

In Order No. 5 filed on July 26, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) continued to find the application incomplete and insufficient and required the applicants to supplement their application to cure the deficiencies by August 23, 2021. The applicants did not supplement their application to cure the deficiencies.

On September 17, 2021, Commission Staff filed a fourth supplemental sufficiency recommendation addressing the administrative completeness of the application.

The ALJ continues to find the application administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By October 22, 2021, applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation filed on July 23, 2021, and the memorandum of Pai Liu, Advisor, Infrastructure Division, dated July 19, 2021.

By November 19, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate, or request to dismiss the application, as appropriate.
