ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the February 11, 2021 petition of the City of Georgetown and Jarrell-Schwertner Water Supply Corporation for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity in Williamson County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

The administrative law judge notes that the applicants filed a response to Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation on March 26, 2021; however, it is unknown if the filing cures the deficiencies of the application. By April 23, 2021, applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation filed on March 25, 2021, and the memorandum of Pai Liu, Advisor, Infrastructure Division, dated March 17, 2021. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By May 24, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
