ORDER NO. 4 ADMITTING EVIDENCE AND RESTYLING DOCKET

This Order addresses the July 22, 2021 joint motion to admit evidence and request to restyle the docket filed by Utilities Investment Company, Inc. dba UIC 13, LLC (UIC) and Commission Staff. The administrative law judge admits the following evidence into the record of this proceeding:

- 8. UIC's response to Commission Staff's first request for information filed on May 27, 2021;
- 9. UIC's consent form filed on June 24, 2021; and
- 10. Commission Staff's final recommendation and all attachments, including the confidential excel spreadsheet, filed on July 15, 2021;

UIC and Commission Staff also requested to restyle the docket to reflect that both certificate of convenience and necessity numbers 13242 and 21091 were issued to UIC 13, LLC and not Utilities Investment Company, Inc. The ALJ restyles the docket as reflected in this Order.
