ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION INCOMPLETE, NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the February 26, 2021 petition of Bernadine C. King, Trustee of the Hinsvark Family Trust (Ms. King) to amend Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bastrop County by streamlined expedited release. On March 29, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively incomplete as described in the memorandum of Patricia Garcia, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. The ALJ finds the notice sufficient.
