**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE
SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses sufficiency of the petition filed by Bernadine C. King, Trustee of the Hinsvark Family Trust filed on February 26, 2021. Bernadine King seeks the expedited release of 217.9 acre tract of land that lies within Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity number 21116 in Bastrop County.

I. Finding Application Administratively Complete

On May 13, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete.

II. Notice

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
