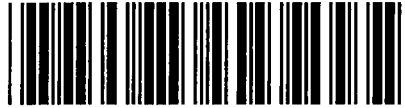

A proposed order was filed on May 26, 2021, in this docket to be heard at a future open meeting. On June 10, 2021, Commission Staff recommended corrections to the proposed order. The administrative law judge finds corrections to the proposed order are appropriate to clarify the temporary rates that would be approved under the proposed order are calculated using the updated connection count provided by CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC. The proposed order is revised as follows.

Opening Paragraph

This Order addresses the application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC for temporary rates for services provided for Farrar Water Supply Corporation, a nonfunctioning utility. The Commission approves the temporary rates proposed in Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition in the application, as modified by this Order and, to the extent provided in this Order. The temporary rates approved by this Order are subject to reconciliation, and the Commission may revise the temporary rates following its reconciliation review.
