Dear Ms. Patterson:

The request submitted for Landmark at Laurel Heights Apartments to change from submetered billing to allocated billing is approved. This approval is based on the facts stated in your letter dated August 14, 2014.

Please note: a tenant's billing method cannot be changed unless they have signed a new lease or a lease addendum, and have been issued a notice at least 35 days prior to implementation of the new billing method. Please reference Title 30, Texas Administrative Code §291.123(c). In the situation where a tenant has been provided proper notice but has not signed a new lease or lease addendum, the property is not authorized to bill them under the new billing method and must continue to bill them in accordance with their existing lease.
