## DOCKET NO. 51863

## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the petition and sufficiency of the notice provided by the City of Pflugerville and Manville Water Supply Corporation. The petitioners seek approval of a service-area contract, under Texas Water Code § 13.248, and to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity in Travis County. On May 3, 2021, petitioners filed a supplement to the petition.

On June 2, 2021, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and sufficiency of the notice. Commission Staff recommended that that petition, as supplemented, be found administratively complete. Further, Commission Staff stated the petitioners met the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.253(c).

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition, as supplemented, administratively complete and notice sufficient. The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for further processing of the application:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to petitioners for review and consent	July 9, 2021
Deadline for petitioners to file signed consent forms with the Commission	July 23, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the petition	July 30, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c) and conclusions of law	August 9, 2021
