COMMISSION STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

On March 2, 2021, the City of Pflugerville (Pflugerville) and Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville) (collectively, Petitioners) filed a petition for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248 and to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Travis County. Under the contract, Manville will transfer a portion of its water service area under CCN number 11144 to Pflugerville's water CCN number 11303. On May 3, 2021, Pflugerville filed supplemental information to the docket.

On June 3, 2020, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 3, establishing July 30, 2021 as the deadline for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application, if no hearing is requested. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental material and, as detailed in the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis of the Infrastructure Division, recommends that it be approved. Along with this recommendation, Staff has attached the map and certificates consented to by the Petitioners in their July 21, 2021 filing.¹ Staff further recommends that the Petitioners file a certified copy of the attached CCN map, along with a written description of the CCN service area in the Travis County Clerk's office, as required by TWC § 13.257(r) and (s). On or before August 9, 2021, the Petitioners and Staff will jointly file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully recommends that the Petitioners' application be approved and that an order be entered consistent with this recommendation.

On March 2, 2021, the City of Pflugerville (Pflugerville) and Manville Water Supply Corporation (Manville WSC) (collectively, Petitioners) filed a petition for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248 and to amend Pflugerville's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11303 and Manville WSC's water CCN No. 11144 in Travis County, Texas. The Petitioners' TWC § 13.248 service area contract is being reviewed in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.253.

The requested area includes 0 current customers and approximately 4.96 acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 11444 to CCN No. 11303).

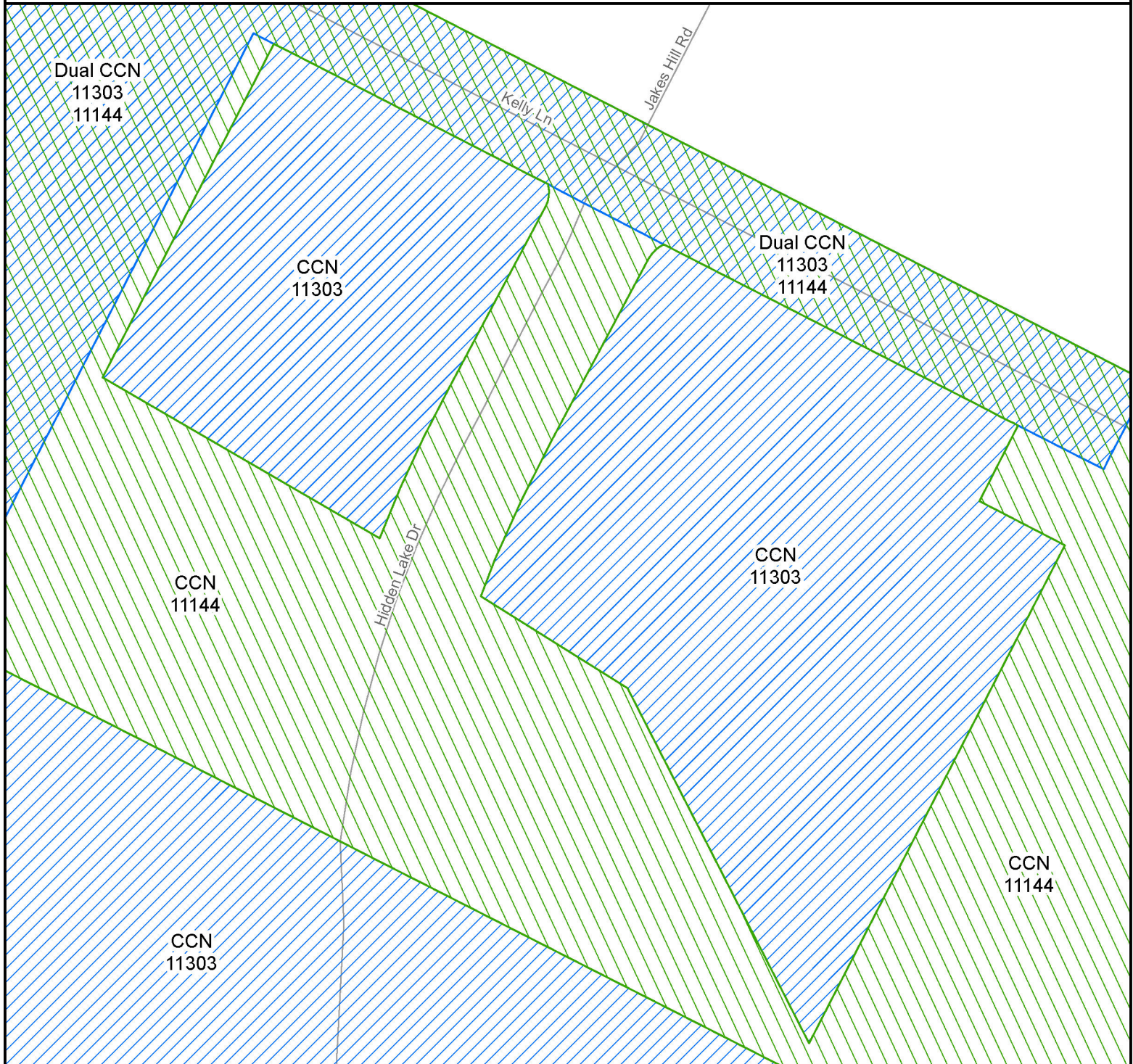
The result of the petition will be the subtraction of approximately 4.96 acres from CCN No. 11444 and the addition of approximately 4.96 acres to CCN No. 11303.

Individual notice was not required for this petition because there are no affected customers in the area subject to the transfer.

The petition meets all applicable statutory requirements of TWC Chapter 13 and 16 TAC Chapter 24 rules and regulations. Therefore, I recommend approval of the petition.
