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

COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO THE CITY OF MIDLOTHIAN QUESTION NOS. STAFF 2-1 THROUGH 2-2

DEFINITIONS

COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO THE CITY OF MIDLOTHIAN QUESTION NOS. STAFF 2-1 THROUGH 2-2

<u>Background</u>: As stated in Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Procedural Schedule filed on March 31, 2021, the requested area overlaps with the certificated service area of Mountain Peak Special Utility District (Mountain Peak SUD), CCN No. 10908. The certificated service area for Mountain Peak SUD is a facility line + 200 feet service line that runs through the requested area. On April 21, 2021, the City provided an agreement between the City and Mountain Peak SUD. The agreement does not state if Mountain Peak SUD agrees to dual certification or decertification.

- Staff 2-1 Please provide written documentation from Mountain Peak SUD affirmatively stating that it is agreeing to dual certification in the requested area. If the requested documentation does not exist, please respond with a statement indicating so.
- As an alternative to the document requested in Staff 1-1, please provide written documentation from Mountain Peak SUD affirmatively stating that it is agreeing to decertification of the facility + 200 feet service line in the requested area. If the requested documentation does not exist, please respond with a statement indicating so.
