**FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the March 2, 2021 application of the City of Midlothian to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Ellis County. Midlothian filed supplemental information on March 10, April 19, 21, and 23, and August 23, 2021.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Midlothian to provide notice of the application as described in the September 27, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
