ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the March 2, 2021 application of the City of Midlothian to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity number 11706 in Ellis County. Midlothian filed supplemental information on March 10, 2021.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By May 3, 2021, applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation filed on March 31, 2021, and the memorandum of Patricia Garcia, senior engineering specialist with the Commission's Infrastructure Division, dated March 29, 2021. Midlothian must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By June 2, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
