**COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW REQUEST FOR REFERRAL**

On March 4, 2021, Forest Glen Utility Company (Forest Glen) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 21070 in Medina County. Forest Glen filed supplemental information on March 5, 2021.

On May 20, 2021, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) filed a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and request for referral. In Order No. 3 filed on June 1, 2021, the administrative laws judge denied the motions to intervene filed in this proceeding for failure to state a justiciable interest.

**I. MOTION TO WITHDRAW REQUEST FOR REFERRAL**

Staff's request for referral was in response to the fact that many of the motions to intervene filed in this proceeding also included a request for hearing. Because those motions have been denied, Staff withdraws its request that this docket be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings for a hearing on the merits.

**II. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully withdraws its request for referral so that this docket may continue to be processed administratively.
