
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APPLICATION OF FOREST GLEN

ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Forest Glen Utility Company. The petitioner seeks approval for the addition of a 185-acre tract of land to its certificates of convenience and necessity in Medina County.

On May 6, 2021, Forest Glen filed the affidavit of Mia Natalino, general manager of Forest Glen, attesting that notice to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties was provided on April 15, 2021. A representative copy of the notices and accompanying map were attached to the affidavit. Additionally, Forest Glen filed a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice of the application in *Hondo Anvil Herald*, a newspaper of general circulation in Medina County, on April 22 and 29, 2021.

On May 20, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice. On June 11, 2021, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the notice. Commission Staff recommends that that the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient. The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for further processing of the application:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of Forest Glen's revised mapping	June 25, 2021
Deadline for Staff to provide the final map, certificate, and tariff (if applicable), to Forest Glen for review and consent	July 27, 2021



Deadline for Forest Glen to file signed consent forms with the Commission	August 10, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	August 17, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	August 24, 2021
