FINDING REVISED MAPPING SUFFICIENT

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the revised mapping provided by Forest Glen Utility Company. On June 8, 2021, the petitioner filed revised mapping and SHP files to reduce the requested area from 405 acres to 185 acres and to confirm that the property belonging to Ms. Ruth Steinle is no longer located within the requested area.

On June 25, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the revised mapping. Commission Staff recommends that the revised mapping be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge finds the revised mapping sufficient. The procedural schedule established in Order No. 5 remains in effect.
