On behalf of Forest Glen Utility Company, we are respectfully submitting a revised page of the Application for Amendment to Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) filed with the Commission on March 4, 2021. This revision reflects the fact that all capital improvements to serve the 185-acre amended CCN area were already constructed, installed and paid for before the filing of the application and no further improvements are necessary to correct any deficiencies or serve the 185-acre area. Per Developer Agreements (already filed in Docket No. 51870 – see AIS 100-101, Bates pages FGU000095-000140), FGU will not bear any responsibility for any on-site improvement costs (i.e., wastewater collection system) and does not have to make any additional on-site improvements in order to serve the additional 185 acres

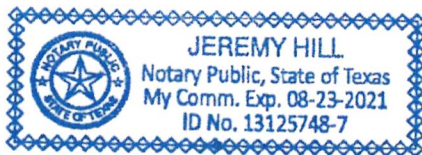
