COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On March 4, 2021, Forest Glen Utility Company (Forest Glen) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 21070 in Medina County. Forest Glen filed supplemental information on March 5, 2021 and revised mapping on June 8, 2021.

On June 14, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5 setting a deadline of August 17, 2021 for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application, and a deadline of August 24, 2021 for the parties to file a joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law if no hearing is requested. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to complete its final recommendation and respectfully requests that it be granted an extension until August 27, 2021 to file its final recommendation. Staff additionally requests that the deadline for the parties to file a joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law be set for September 10, 2021 to accommodate this request for extension.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order extending the deadline to August 27, 2021 to file its final recommendation, and that the deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law be set for September 10, 2021
