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APPLICATION OF FOREST GLEN UTILITY COMPANY TO AMEND ITS SEWER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN MEDINA COUNTY PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS

COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 10 REQUESTING CLARIFICATION

March 4, 2021, Forest Glen Utility Company (Forest Glen) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 21070 in Medina County. Forest Glen filed supplemental information on March 5, 2021 and revised mapping on June 8, 2021.

On September 24, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 10, requesting Staff to file a clarification and identify the database it references and provide a copy of the search results. Order No. 10 also asks that Commission Staff identify all databases used to track complaints against a public water system. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. COMMISSION STAFF'S CLARIFICATION

Upon reviewing the complaint records, Staff has determined that it had inadvertently and incorrectly stated the number of complaints against Forest Glen, and therefore wishes to be granted an opportunity to revise its memo and clarify the record. As reflected by the attachment herein, twelve (12) complaints have been filed against Forest Glen. Staff clarifies that Staff requests the number of complaints from the Intake Center Coordinator in the Department of the Customer Protection Division. A copy of the database is attached to this filing. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that it be granted a deadline of October 15, 2021 to file a revised memo and to address any other additional necessary matters to continue the processing of this matter.
