ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the March 4, 2021 application of Forest Glen Utility Company to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 21070 in Medina County. Forest Glen filed supplemental information on March 5, 2021.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Forest Glen to provide notice of the application as described in the March 31, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
