



COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

On March 5, 2021, the City of Woodway (Woodway) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) 10022 and for dual certification with the City of Waco's CCN number 10039 in McClennan County. The amendment proposes to add approximately 170 acres and 450 customers.

On April 6, 2021 the administrative law judge filed Order No. 2, setting a deadline of June 4, 2021 for Staff of the Public Commission of Texas (Staff) to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and propose a procedural schedule. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to review the application. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application to June 25, 2021.
