ORDER NO. 16 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by L and T Waterworks LLC and Monarch Utilities I, L.P.

On March 16, 2022, applicants filed the affidavit of George Freitag, Texas Regulatory Manager of Monarch, attesting that direct notice was mailed to affected parties, along with the map provided by Commission Staff. On March 31, 2022, applicants filed publishers' affidavits, attesting to the publication of notice in the *Athens Daily Review*, a newspaper of general circulation in Henderson County on February 19 and 26, 2022, and in the *Fairfield Recorder*, a newspaper of general circulation in Freestone County, on February 24 and March 3, 2022.

On April 13, 2022, Commission Staff filed recommendations regarding notice and proposed a procedural for continued processing

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule, as proposed, applies:
