> Re: Application of L and T Waterworks LLC and Monarch Utilities I L.P. for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificate Rights in Freestone and Henderson Counties; Docket No. 51877; Response to Order No. 2 Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Establishing an Opportunity to Cure, and Entering Protective Order

Dear Central Records:

Enclosed please find a supplemental application, being filed to cure deficiencies pursuant to Order No. 2 Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Establishing an Opportunity to Cure, and Entering Protective Order, issued in the above-referenced matter on April 12, 2021.

Monarch, Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12983, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water service area from L and T Waterworks under water CCN Nos. 12919 and 12993, to obtain dual certification with Turlington Water Supply Corporation (WSC), CCN No. 10793, to decertify a portion of South Freestone WSC, CCN No. 10791, and to amend uncertificated area in Freestone and Henderson Counties.

In the initial application, hereafter referred to as STM Application #1, the maps provided in the STM Application #1 showed a broad overview of actions involving the individual CCN holders Monarch Utilities I L.P., L and T Waterworks LLC, Turlington WSC, South Freestone County WSC, Curtis D. Logan d/b/a L and T Waterworks, LLC formerly W.R. Coffey d/b/a Moody Land Company, and Athens Water System Coop without the individual maps indicating each act involved in the decertification, dual certification, transfer, addition, or removal of the above-mentioned areas.

In this response, Monarch is providing maps to address each individual request and further clarifies the same to address and correct all boundary and overlap issues that Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Staff raised in their Recommendation filed on April 8, 2021. Monarch has consulted with the Commission Staff to confirm that these revisions address and correct the deficiencies noted.

Attached for submissions are:

- 1. A revised General Location Map for the Moody System in Freestone County.
- 2. A revised Detailed Map of the Moody System showing the various additions and changes to the service area requested designated by numbered polygons.
- 3. Individual maps corresponding to each of the separate actions associated with the acquisition of the Moody System Polygons 1, 2, 3, and 5.



- 4. A revised detailed map for the requested area of the Athens System to be transferred. Please note that Monarch is not requesting any changes or adjustments to the service area boundary of this system and is requesting that it be transferred to CCN No. 12983 as it currently is mapped.
- 5. And, based on the recommendation of the Staff, a supplemental application, STM #2, is filed to separately address the requested transfer of a portion of the service area of South Freestone County WSC to the Moody System, addressed in Polygon 4.
