**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Monarch utilities I, L.P.

On July 28, 2021, Maonarch filed: (1) the affidavit of George H. Freitag, Monarch’s authorized representative, attesting that individual notice was mailed to all required parties on July 14, 2021; and (2) a publisher’s affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in the *Houston Business Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in Harris, Chambers, Liberty, Montgomery, Waller, Fort Bend, Brazoria, and Galveston counties, on July 9 and 16, 2021.


On August 17, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding Monarch’s notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds Monarch’s notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Event	Date
Notice completed	July 16, 2021
Deadline for intervention	August 15, 2021
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Monarch for review and consent	September 29, 2021
Deadline for Monarch to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 13, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	October 27, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	November 10, 2021
