**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the March 16, 2021 application of Monarch Utilities I L.P. to amend its water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Harris and Liberty counties.


The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before May 13, 2021, Monarch Utilities must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the April 13, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Monarch Utilities must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before June 10, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
