**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Quadvest, L.P. regarding its application to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity number 11612 and sewer CCN number 20952 in Montgomery County. On July 22, 2021, Quadvest filed: (1) the affidavit of Yvette McNellie, partner of Quadvest, attesting that individual notice was mailed to all required parties on June 30, 2021; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in the *Houston Chronicle* dba *Cypress Creek Mirror*, a newspaper of general circulation in Montgomery County on July 7 and 14, 2021.

On August 12, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding Quadvest's notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds Quadvest's notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on the application	October 3, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	October 11, 2021
