**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On March 22, 2021, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County, Texas.

On January 27, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 9, setting a deadline of April 1, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to provide a final recommendation or request a hearing. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.
