COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On March 22, 2021, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County, Texas.

On June 10, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 14, setting a deadline of June 30, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to provide a final recommendation or request a hearing. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to review the information filed by Quadvest on June 13, 2022 and to generally determine whether the application provided by Quadvest is administratively complete, and whether material insufficiencies persist in this matter. In order to allow staff adequate time to reach its conclusion, and to coordinate with Quadvest on any such material insufficiencies, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to provide a final recommendation be extended until July 30, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests its deadline be extended until July 30, 2022.
