COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On March 22, 2021, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County, Texas.

On December 1, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 21, setting a deadline of December 14, 2022 for the parties to file their joint proposed findings of fact and motion to admit evidence. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. The parties are continuing to work to finalize their joint filings. Therefore, Staff requests that the deadline to file a joint motion to admit evidence and joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law be extended to December 21, 2022.
