#### **COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On March 22, 2021, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County, Texas.

On December 15, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 22, setting a deadline of December 28, 2022 for the parties to file their joint proposed findings of fact and motion to admit evidence. Staff apologizes for the untimely filing of this request for an extension.

#### I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. The parties are continuing to work to finalize their joint filings. Therefore, Staff requests that the deadline to file a joint motion to admit evidence and joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law be extended to January 11, 2023.

#### **II. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons outlined above, Staff respectfully requests the deadline for the parties to submit their joint filings be extended to January 11, 2023.
