**ORDER NO. 34**  
**FINDING NOTICE, AS SUPPLEMENTED, SUFFICIENT AND SOLICITING MOTION**  
**TO ADMIT SUPPLEMENTAL EVIDENCE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of Quadvest, LP's application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On June 7, 2023, Quadvest filed supplemental notice in response to Order No. 32, which consists of the affidavit of Mark L. Urback, vice president of engineering and construction for of Quadvest, attesting that there are no landowners with a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and is wholly or partially included in the requested area other than the developer.

On June 30, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the supplemental notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice, as supplemented, sufficient. The ALJ requests the parties file, by July 14, 2023, a supplemental motion to admit as evidence in the record of this proceeding Quadvest's response to Order No. 32 filed on June 7, 2023, and Commission Staff's recommendation on supplemental notice filed on June 30, 2023.
