#### MONTGOMERY ESTATES, LLC'S REPLY TO CC WATER WORKS, INC.'S RESPONSE TO ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE PETITION AND COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

COMES NOW, Montgomery Estates, LLC (Montgomery Estates), by and through its undersigned attorneys of record, and hereby files this Reply to CC Water Works, Inc.'s (CCWW) Response to Administratively Complete Petition (the Petition) and Commission Staff's Recommendation on Final Disposition (the Reply). In support thereof, Montgomery Estates would respectfully show as follows:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On March 24, 2021, Montgomery Estates filed its Petition to Amend CCWW's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Chambers County by Streamlined Expedited Release under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.254(h) (the Petition) with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the Commission). On May 26, 2021, Montgomery Estates filed a Supplement to the Petition. On June 29, 2021, Commission Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Siemankowski issued Order No. 4 Finding Petition, as Supplemented, Administratively Complete, and Establishing Procedural Schedule, setting: (i) a deadline of July 19, 2021 for CCWW to file a response to the administratively complete Petition; (ii) a deadline of August 2, 2021 for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on final disposition; and (iii) a deadline of August 9, 2021 for Montgomery Estates to file a reply to CCWW's response to the administratively complete Petition and Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition. On July 19, 2021, CCWW filed a response to the administratively complete petition (Response). On August 2, 2021, Commission Staff filed their Recommendation on Final Disposition (Recommendation) requesting that the Petition be approved and an order be issued consistent with the Recommendation. Therefore, this Reply is timely filed.

#### II. CC WATER WORKS, INC.'S RESPONSE IS UNTIMELY

CCWW's Response is untimely and should not be considered. CCWW filed its Response to the administratively complete Petition on the Commission Interchange on July 19, 2021, at 3:17:30 p.m., as confirmed by the electronic timestamp on its filing. Title 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.71(h) states that "[a]ll documents shall be filed by 3:00 p.m. on the date due, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding officer." 16 TAC § 22.71(e) states that "[p]leadings and any other document shall be deemed filed when the required number of copies and the electronic copy, if required, in conformance with § 22.72 of this title are presented to the commission clerk for filing. ..." According to the Commission Interchange, effective July 13, 2021, electronic filing submissions are complete after submitting through the Commission Interchange Filer. Here, CCWW's Response was filed after 3:00 p.m. on the date due. Therefore, CCWW's Response should be found untimely and not worthy of consideration in this Docket.

#### III. REPLY TO CC WATER WORKS, INC.'S UNTIMELY RESPONSE

Should the ALJ find that CCWW's Response was timely or consider the substance of the Response, Montgomery Estates maintains that the Petition is administratively complete and should be granted, as requested. In its Response, CCWW alleges that Montgomery Estates provided insufficient notice of the Petition. However, as Montgomery Estates has already clarified in its

May 11, 2021 Reply to CC Water Works, Inc.'s Response to Petition, Montgomery Estates properly provided notice of the Petition in accordance with the applicable Commission Rule, 16 TAC § 24.245(h)(3)(F). This rule requires a petitioner seeking streamlined expedited release to provide in its petition "proof that a copy of the petition was mailed to the current CCN holder via certified mail on the day that the landowner filed the petition with the commission." According to 16 TAC § 22.74(b)(1), "[s]ervice by mail shall be complete upon deposit of the document, enclosed in a wrapper properly addressed, stamped and sealed, in a post office or official depository of the United States Postal Service, except state agencies." On March 24, 2021, Montgomery Estates mailed a copy of the Petition to CCWW's address on record with the Commission and filed its Petition at the Commission, including a copy of the U.S. Postal Service Certified Mail Receipt (the Service).

On April 9, 2021, the undersigned attorneys for Montgomery Estates received the Service with a "return to sender" label indicating that CCWW rejected service. Although Montgomery Estates had fully complied with 16 TAC §§ 24.245(h)(3)(F) and 22.74(b)(1), as a courtesy, it mailed another copy of the Petition to CCWW's registered agent on record at the Secretary of State on April 16, 2021 (Supplemental Service). On April 22, 2021, Supplemental Service was accepted by CCWW's registered agent. Attached as <u>Exhibit A</u> to this Reply is the Affidavit of Christina Thompson, providing additional details and supporting documents regarding the filing of this Petition, the Service of the Petition on CCWW, and the Supplemental Service (previously filed with Montgomery Estates' May 11, 2021 Reply).

CCWW also alleges in its Response that the CCN decertification, as proposed by the Petition, would deny CCWW's ability to serve some or all of the acreage within CCWW's CCN, resulting in financial and operational harm. Based on those premises, CCWW seeks compensation for any decertified property. However, CCWW's ability to serve is not a factor under TWC § 13.2541 and the Petition should be granted since it has been found administratively complete. TWC § 13.2541(b) allows "the owner of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and that is not receiving water or sewer service" to petition for expedited release "and is entitled to that release" if the tract is one of the counties described therein. TWC § 13.2541(c) states that the Commission "shall grant the petition not later than the 60th day after the date the landowner files the petition." Therefore, whether or not the proposed decertification will affect CCWW's ability to serve some or all of its current CCN service area is irrelevant to this Petition. The Petition has been found administratively complete and should be granted by August 27, 2021—the 60th day after administrative approval.

As to CCWW's allegations regarding compensation, Montgomery Estates asserts that such allegations are irrelevant and not yet ripe, as the regulatory rubric for CCN decertification by streamlined expedited release provides that the compensation process does not commence until after the petition is approved. Commission Rule 16 TAC § 24.245(i) states that "[t]he amount of compensation, if any, will be determined after the commission has granted a petition for streamlined expedited release filed under subsection (h) of this section. The amount of compensation, if any, will be decided in the same proceeding as the petition for streamlined expedited release." Accordingly, Montgomery Estates will refrain from explaining why CCWW is not entitled to any compensation in this matter at this time and instead make those arguments later in this regulatory process, once the Petition is granted.

Thus, the arguments asserted in CCWW's untimely Response regarding notice and compensation should be disregarded not only because they are untimely, but also because: (i) Montgomery Estates has provided proof that notice was properly served on CCWW; and (ii) compensation is not a factor to be considered by the Commission when deciding whether to decertify land from a CCN under TWC §§ 13.254 and 13.2541, and 16 TAC § 24.245.

#### IV. REPLY TO STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

Montgomery Estates agrees with Commission Staff's Recommendation that the ALJ: (i) approve the Petition for streamlined expedited release from CCWW's CCN No. 13038 in Chambers County; and (ii) issue an order consistent with that Recommendation.

#### V. CONCLUSION & PRAYER

For these reasons, Montgomery Estates, LLC, respectfully requests that the presiding ALJ:

(i) find CCWW's Response untimely; (ii) find that Montgomery Estates provided adequate notice

to CCWW of the Petition and that the Petition is administratively complete; (iii) issue an order

approving the Petition; and (iv) grant all other and further relief to which it may be entitled.
