Enclosed is an evaluation to determine compensation for the area in question subjected to expedited release in Docket 51933. Montgomery Estates, LLC. requested to have an approximately 100-acre tract decertified from the certificated water service area of CC Water Works, Inc. The Texas Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) granted this expedited release of the requested area. This evaluation was prepared to determine CC Water Works, Inc.'s amount of just and reasonable compensation for loss of this service area. A review was conducted to determine if the utility should be compensated based on each factor as provided. All documentation to support compensation in each factor for which the utility is due justifiable compensation is attached to this evaluation.

## **GOVERNING STATUTE AND RULES:**

This determination was performed in accordance with Texas Water Code (TWC) §13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §24.245(j). Per this ruling statue, the determined value of compensation should be based on the following factors ensuring that the compensation to a retail public utility is just and adequate:

- 1. the amount of the retail public utility's debt allocable for service to the area in question
- 2. the value of the service facilities of the retail public utility located within the area in question

- 3. the amount of any expenditures for planning, design, or construction of service facilities that are allocable to service to the area in question
- 4. the amount of the retail public utility's contractual obligations allocable to the area in question
- 5. any demonstrated impairment of service or increase of cost to consumers of the retail public utility remaining after the decertification
- 6. the impact on future revenues lost from existing customers
- 7. necessary and reasonable legal expenses and professional fees
- 8. and other relevant factors.

## **ANALYSIS OF COMPENSATION FACTORS:**

1. "the amount of the retail public utility's debt allocable for service to the area in question"

The utility does not find any debts that would be allocable to the area in question.

## 2. "the value of service facilities of the retail public utility located within the area in question"

CC Water Works, Inc. does not have any service facilities with the area in question.

# 3. "the amount of any expenditures for planning, design, or construction of service facilities that are allocable to service to the area in question"

The utility did not find any expenditures for planning, design, or construction of service facilities applicable to the area in question,

## 4. "the amount of the retail public utility's contractual obligations allocable to the area in question"

No contract obligations were discovered for CC Water Works, Inc. that would be allocable to the area in question.

# 5. "any demonstrated impairment of service or increase of cost to consumers of the retail public utility remain after the decertification"

CC Water Works, Inc. will not be allowed to serve customers in the area being decertified and the area is proposed for residential housing development. Additional revenues above expenses (net income) from proposed connections in the decertified area in question could be used to offset the cost of future operating expenses, capital expenditures, etc. Thus, revenues that will be generated from customers added in the decertified area should be considered as a potential increase to the cost to consumers of the utility due to the loss of this future income.

To determine an estimate of additional revenues that will not be collect from connections in the decertified area, a net income per customer was determined using the last available PUC Annual Report for the utility.<sup>1</sup> Based on the financial date in this report, a net income amount per customer for the utility was calculated. Calculation No.1 shows the computation of this amount per customer.

## Calculation 1: Net Income per Customer

Next, a projected number of connections that could be added in the decertified area was determined. Based on the septic requirements of Chambers County, a new home could be placed on each acre of land.<sup>2</sup> Since the decertified tract is approximately 100 acres then the potential number of connections that could be constructed in the area in question would be 100. A discounted flow analysis was conducted for the potential loss net revenues from these 100 connections to calculate a net present value of this revenues stream. Calculation

2 is a discounted cash flow model to calculate a net present value over the next 20 year using a discounted rate of 10 percent.

## Calculation 2: Discounted Cash Flow Model

Based on this analysis, the increase of cost to consumers of the retail public utility remain after the decertification for this factor would be \$202,741.

## 6. "the impact on future revenues lost from existing customers"

CC Water Works, Inc. does not currently service any customer in the CCN service area being decertified. Thus, no potential impact will occur on future revenues.

## 7. "necessary and reasonable legal expenses and professional fees"

CC Water Works, Inc. should be allowed to recover all reasonable and necessary legal fees along with professional fees associated with its participation in this Docket. Calculation 3 is the total of all legal and professional fees incurred by the utility so far in this Docket. In addition, anticipated legal fees to occur before final resolution of this matter are included. If any additional fees are incurred by the utility, then this compensation factor made need to be adjusted.

Based on this evaluation, the recommended just and adequate compensation CC Water Works, Inc. should receive for the decertification from its CCN service area of the 100-acre tract should be **\$ 220,818** as summarized in Table 1.

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IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE COUNTY OF CHAMBERS FOR A TEXAS HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE §366.031 ORDER BEFORE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

On <u>FEB 2 0 2008</u> the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("Commission" or "TCEQ"), considered the application of the County of Chambers, ("Applicant" or "Chambers"), for an Order pursuant to §366.031, Texas Health and Safety Code ("Code"), and 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §285.10 of the rules of the Commission.

No person has requested a public hearing on the application, therefore the Executive Director, on behalf of the Commission, is satisfied that the Applicant has satisfied the requirements of §366.031 of the Code and, therefore, the Commission finds that the Chambers County Order should be approved.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The County of Chambers drafted a proposed amendment to its order which regulates on-site sewage facilities.
- 2. On May 31, 2006 the County of Chambers caused notice to be published, in a newspaper regularly published and of general circulation, in the Applicant's area of jurisdiction, of a public meeting to be held on June 13, 2006.
- 3. The County of Chambers held a public meeting to discuss the proposed amendment to its order on June 13, 2006.
- 4. Chambers County's Order regulating on-site sewage facilities was adopted on June 13, 2006.
- 5. A certified copy of the minutes was submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 6. A certified copy of the Chambers County Order was submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 7. The order is at least equivalent to the standards of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

# EXHIBIT "A"

#### AN ORDER ENTITLED ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITIES

SECTION 4. CONFLICTS.

This Order repeals and replaces any other On-site Sewage Facility order for Chambers County.

SECTION 5. CHAPTER 366.

The County of Chambers, Texas clearly understands that there are technical criteria, legal requirements, and administrative procedures and duties associated with regulating on-site sewage facilities, and will fully enforce Chapter 366 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (H&SC) and Chapters 7 and 37 of the Texas Water Code (TWC), and associated rules referenced in Section 8 of this Order.

SECTION 6. AREA OF JURISDICTION.

(A) The Rules shall apply to all the area lying in Chambers County, Texas, except for the area regulated under an existing Rule and the areas within incorporated cities.
 (B) (OPTIONAL) These Rules shall apply to those incorporated cities or towns that

have executed intergovernmental contracts with Chambers County, Texas.

SECTION 7. ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITY RULES.

Any permit issued for an on-site sewage facility within the jurisdictional area of Chambers County, Texas must comply with the Rules adopted in Section 8 of this Order.

SECTION 8. ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITY RULES ADOPTED.

The Rules, Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 285 and Chapter 30, attached hereto, promulgated by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for on-site sewage facilities are hereby adopted, and all officials and employees of Chambers County, Texas having duties under said Rules are authorized to perform such duties as are required of them under said Rules.

SECTION 9. INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE.

The Rules, 30 TAC Chapters 30 and 285 and all future amendments and revisions thereto are incorporated by reference and are thus made a part of these Rules. A copy of the current Rules are attached to these Rules as Appendix I.

## SECTION 10. AMENDMENTS.

The County of Chambers, Texas wishing to adopt more stringent Rules for its On-Site Sewage Facility Order understands that the more stringent conflicting local Rule shall take precedence over the corresponding Texas Commission on Environmental Quality requirement. Listed below are the more stringent Rules adopted by Chambers County, Texas:

(A) All on-site sewage facilities, whether standard, non-standard or proprietary, must be designed under the seal of a Registered Sanitarian or Registered Licensed Engineer in accordance with the design standards set up in these Rules and the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission Rules for OSSF and approved by the local authority of Chambers County Environmental Health Department.

(B) All on-site sewage facilities, regardless of acreage, will be required to meet all State and County Standards and be permitted by Chambers County.

(C) Platted subdivisions of single family dwellings, platted or created after June 1, 2006, served by a public water supply, but utilizing individual on-site sewage facilities must provide for individual lots having surface areas of at least 32,670 sq. Ft. (.75 acres), exclusive of roadways and ditches. Platted subdivisions of single family dwellings platted or created after served by an individual water system and utilizing individual on-site sewage facilities must provide for individual lots having surface areas of at least 43,560 sq. ft. (1.0 acres) exclusive of roadways and ditches.

(D) The authorized agent may periodically inspect the on-site sewage disposal system using mechanical devices for a single-family residence regardless of when the authorized agent conducted the last inspection.

(E) When a visual and audible alarm is required for an on-site sewage facility connected to a "Food Establishment", and additional visual and audible alarm shall be located or installed inside the facility, located in an area conspicuous to view by employees or management. (For the purpose for this Order, a "Food Establishment" is an operation that stores, prepares, packages, serves, or otherwise provides food for human consumption, such as: a food establishment; retail food store; satellite or catered feeding location; catering operation; if the operation provides food directly to a consumer or to a conveyance used to transport people; market; remote catered operations; conveyance used to transport people; institution; or food bank; and that relinquishes possession of food to a consumer directly, or indirectly through a delivery services such as home delivery of grocery orders or restaurant takeout orders, or delivery service that is provided by common carriers).

(F) For systems controlled by a commercial irrigation timer and required to spray between midnight and 5:00 a.m., there shall be at least one and one-third days of storage between the alarm-on level and the pump-on level, and a storage volume of one-third of the daily flow between the alarm-on level and the inlet to the pump tank..

## SECTION 11. DUTIES AND POWERS.

The OSSF Inspector of Chambers County, Texas, must be certified by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before assuming the duties and responsibilities.

SECTION 12. COLLECTION OF FEES.

## SECTION 15 or 16. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Order shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of approval as required by law and upon the approval of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

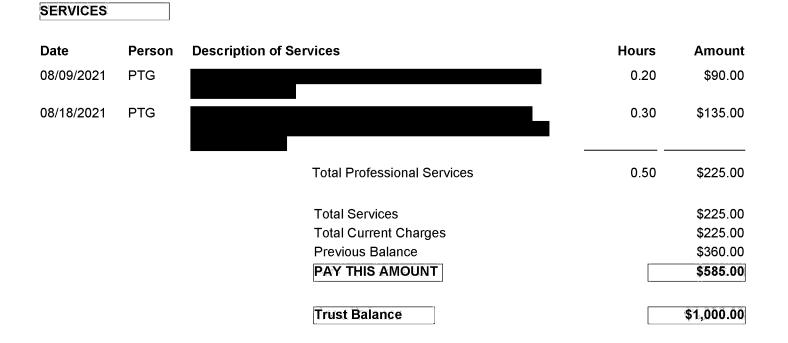

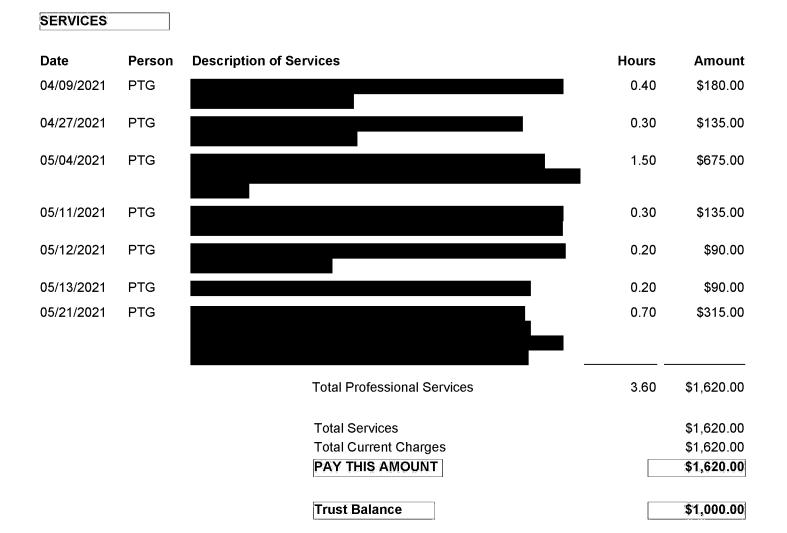

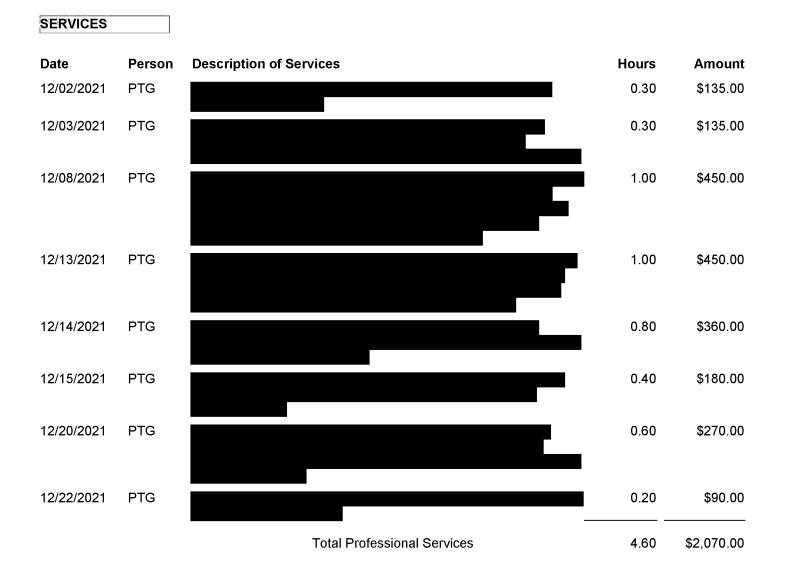
